



Lawnton Post 998 Home Association House Rules

1. Club operating hours will be as posted.
2. Club must be vacated 30 minutes after last call.

NOTE

No one will be admitted into the club after closing hours. Rules 1 and 2 above can be changed at the discretion of the Manager and with the concurrence of the Home Association President. If hours are required to be changed, a notification of changes will be made to the Executive Committee at the first available meeting, for acknowledgement and concurrence.

3. **All persons entering the Club are required to show a membership card before they can be served.** Active, SAL, Auxiliary or Social. When in doubt as to a person's age, they will be required to show appropriate proof of age, prior to being served. Those members who are in the armed service and under 21 years of age will have their membership card stamped accordingly. Adherence to the drinking age is a Pennsylvania State Law.....
4. Membership cards must be shown to the Bartender, Waitress, Post Officer, Manager, or President of the Home Association upon request.
5. Customers possessing membership cards from another American Legion Post may be honored. Social membership cards from a Post other than Post 998 will not be honored.
6. Guests will not be permitted unless accompanied by a member in good standing. Guests residing within local driving distance (25 mile radius of Post 998) will not be permitted as a guest more than 3 times. Active members may sign in (2) guests, Auxiliary (1) guest, S.A.L. (1) Guest, Social (0) Guests.
7. All guests and their Members/Sponsors must sign the "Guest Register". Guests are not permitted to purchase alcohol. Members will be responsible for their guests at all times and the guest must leave the premises when their sponsor leaves.
8. Minors will not be permitted in the building unless accompanied by a Parent or Guardian, who is a member in good standing. Minors must leave the building by 9:00 PM, unless present for a Special Post function.
9. **Conduct:** Proper conduct is required at all times. Fighting (punching) is grounds for immediate dismissal and permanent disbarment pending action from the Executive committee.
10. Members using profanity, destroying post property, defaming the post, threatening other patrons or otherwise conducting themselves in a disorderly manner, will be immediately asked to leave. Depending on the degree of disorderly conduct further actions may be taken and could be elevated to the Executive Committee for pending action.

11. Non members conducting themselves in a manner identified in 9 and 10 above, will be permanently barred from Post 998.

12. The Bartender, Club Manager or President of the Home Association have the authority to eject any person in accordance with rule 9 and 10 above. The Club Manager or President of the Home Association, have the authority to order and immediate suspension for any member charged with breaking rule 9 or 10 pending a decision of the Post 998 Executive Committee.

a. Any action of this nature will be brought to the attention of the Offender by the appropriate post authority within 72 hours, or as soon as practical / possible.

b. Post 998 members will be afforded a hearing before the Post Commander / Judge Advocate and an appointed committee. The results of the hearing will be presented to the Executive Committee with a ruling for their review and approval.....

c. Non members of Post 998 have no right to appeal.

13. **The Bartender on duty is in charge:** Members interfering with the bartenders duties or challenging their decisions will be asked to leave. Any complaints regarding the Bartender shall be made to the Manager or President of the Home Association, and must be in writing. The only individuals allowed behind the bar are the Manager, Waitresses, and President of the Home Association. If a Bartender asks for assistance from a member of the club, ex: (change a keg) the member then has permission to do so.

a. The Bartenders and Club Manager are the only persons authorized to operate the controls for the TV's, Juke Box, Lights, and any and all equipment associated with the environment of the club. If a Bartender asks for assistance from a member of the club, the member then has permission to do so.

15. **Kitchen:** The kitchen is off limits to all Members, except for Board Members, Employees, and those designated to use the kitchen for special functions and properly briefed on its safe operation..... **No exceptions.**

14. **Proper attire will be worn at all times:** All members will be required to wear clothing appropriate to the Veterans organization we belong to: **Men-No cutoff tee shirts or sleeveless tee shirts allowed. Ball caps will be worn with the bill facing forward. Women- No tube tops allowed.**

16. **Solicitations:** Sales and soliciting are prohibited unless approved by the Club Manager.

17. This is a **smoking establishment** and will be operated within the guidelines of the State of Pennsylvania's clean air act. Act 27 of 2008, the Clean Indoor Air Act.
